**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, dated 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2002

S.O. 3720 – Whereas, in pursuance of the Convention on International Civil Aviation opened for signatures at Chicago on the 7<sup>th</sup> December, 1944 and the Air Services Agreements or Air Transport Agreements entered into by India with parties to the said Convention, it is necessary to grant exemption from levy of taxes and duties on fuel and lubricants filled into receptacles forming part of any aircraft of any country or countries (other than India) which is or are parties to the said Convention or Agreement;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Foreign Aircraft (Exemption from Taxes and Duties On Fuel and Lubricants) Act, 2002 (36 of 2002), the Central Government hereby notifies that the fuel and lubricants filled into receptacles forming part of any aircraft registered in any other countries (other than India) which is a party to the said Convention or which has entered into the said Agreement with India, and operating a scheduled or non-scheduled international air service to or from India, shall be exempted from levy of all taxes and duties in India whether levied by the Central Government or the State Government, as the case may be.
