FLIGHT CREW LICENSING CIRCULAR No 3/2007

Dated 18th July, 2007

Subject: Medical Assessment regarding.

Many individuals have reported that they are not able to receive the medical assessments in time. On examination it has been observed that the Class-II medical records of the individuals are forwarded to DGCA without any covering files. Such papers when received in DGCA in bulk are likely to get separated from the bundle of the individual. Secondly, there might be typographical error in the postal address.

Therefore, for the convenience of all individuals it has been decided by the competent authority that all the doctors whoever is forwarding the class-II medical records of the individuals must ensure that class-II medical records should be:-

1. neatly placed in the files before posting/submitting to DGCA.
2. accompanied with individual's self addressed envelop having postage stamp affixed on the envelop.
