OPERATIONS CIRCULAR NO. 2 OF 2006

**Subject: Age of Instructor / Examiners of Scheduled/Non-scheduled/
General Aviation Operators**

In the interest of Safety of Aircraft Operations, it was decided that Scheduled/Non-scheduled/General Aviation Operators shall not utilize their Examiners/Instructors approved by DGCA on Aircraft / Helicopters for the purpose of Training/Skill Tests of Pilots for Co-pilot Rating / Initial Type Endorsement and also Initial issue of Instrument Rating after they have attained 60 years of age.

The matter has been reviewed and it is now decided that the above functions can be performed by Examiner/Instructor above 60 years of age subject to the condition that a type qualified Commander less than 60 years of age having no medical restriction placed on his licence shall be on board as 'Safety Pilot', to takeover in extreme situation needing replacement of such examiner or instructor.

All operators are advised to comply with the above instructions and incorporate the same in their Operations/Training Manual.

Operations Circular 1 of 2006 stands withdrawn.
