Subject: **QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION IN AME TRAINING INSTITUTES**

In accordance with subrule 5 of Rule 61 of the Aircraft Rules, 1937, an applicant for the grant of Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Licence shall satisfy the following requirements, namely:-

“(5) An applicant for the grant of Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Licence shall satisfy the following requirements, namely:-

- (a) he shall not be less than 18 years of age;*
- (b) he shall have passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects from a recognized Board or University or its equivalent examination;*
- (c) he shall have passed a written examination as specified by the Director-General.”*

CAR Section 2 Series E Part VIII regarding Approval of Organisations - Category 'G' - Training Institutes is accordingly being revised to include the above provisions.

Meanwhile, Accountable Managers/ Chief Instructors of AME Training Institutes are hereby advised to ensure that the candidates being inducted by them for July 2011 batch and subsequent batches should fulfill the condition of having passed 10+2 examination with aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects from a recognized Board or University or its equivalent examination.

The above is for strict adherence by all concerned.
