Subject: Recent initiatives to improve working of CEO, DGCA

- I. Generation of computer number on monthly and continuing basis.
- II. Candidate can now take acknowledgement of the application submitted in the CEO for the purpose of appearing in examinations.
- III. Frequency of examination/special exam increased to increase opportunities to appear in exams.
- IV. Decentralised system of screening of rejected applications at regional offices
- V. Time bound declaration of results of exams. (3 to 4 weeks from date of examination)
- VI. 42 days period required for re-appearing in any exam reduced to 4 weeks to facilitate candidates to appear in exams.
- VII. Officers from Flight Standards Directorate posted in the CEO for the preparation/vetting of the question papers for the pilots' license examination.
- VIII. The question bank for examinations being generated/ revised by the subject matters experts at par with FAA/ EASA syllabus.
