Attention of the concerned is drawn towards provisions of Para (4) of Rule 41A of Aircraft Rules, 1937, under which Director General may debar permanently or temporarily a candidate from any flying tests or examination if, in his opinion, the applicant has adopted unfair means during the tests or examination.

Candidates appearing in CEO examination conducted from time to time are cautioned against use of unfair means in the examination. Recently, eight candidates have been debarred from appearing in examination for varying periods ranging from one year to more.
